INGREDIENT(S):
virginiamycin
USE:
Necrotic enteritis (Clostridium perfringens), control/prevention
SPECIES:
Chickens
ROA:
In the feed
DOSE:
Broilers: Mix 0.5 kg (22 g virginiamycin)/tonne complete feed to provide 1 mg/kg b.w./day. Feed continuously as
sole ration from weaning to market weight.
WITHDRAWAL TIME:
Meat: 0d
WT NOTES:
Do not feed to birds producing eggs for human consumption.
USE:
Swine dysentery, control/prevention
Swine dysentery, treatment
SPECIES:
Swine
ROA:
In the feed
DOSE:
For treatment and control: Feed continuously as sole ration.
For treatment and control. Feed continuously as sole fation.
First 2 weeks: Mix 2.5 kg (110 g virginiamycin)/tonne complete feed to provide 5 mg/kg b.w./day.
Next 4 weeks: Mix 1.25 kg (55 g virginiamycin)/tonne complete feed to provide 2.5 mg/kg b.w./day.
After finishing medication at 55 g/tonne, if dysentery re-occurs, re-treat with above regimen.
